Equity-League Combined Pension and 401(K) Funds' Continuation of a <u>Former</u> Spouse as a Beneficiary Form

(You Must <u>Use</u> the Funds' standard and separate Beneficiary Forms for Pension & 401(K), if you want to make an initial beneficiary designation, designate different beneficiaries after a marriage terminates, or change allocations to your beneficiaries for Pension and 401(K) Benefits)

Effective January 1, 2015, the Equity-League Pension & 401(K) Funds ("Funds") adopted a new policy for participants who have designated their spouse as beneficiary: Once a participant becomes divorced, or has his or her marriage legally annulled, the ex-spouse is automatically removed as that participant's beneficiary for any benefits under the Funds, unless a Qualified Domestic Relations Order ("QDRO") provides otherwise. While this change reflects what the Funds believe the majority of participants prefer, we understand that some participants will want to retain their former spouses as beneficiaries. If you wish your ex-spouse to continue as your beneficiary after a divorce (and there is no QDRO to that effect), you must re-designate your ex-spouse as your beneficiary.
